

Rules and Information for Novelty Classes – Owners Pony & Young Riders Charity Show

Ride & Cycle Classes

1. Competitors will jump a course of fences followed by cycling a bicycle around a track in the arena. The fastest time with lowest faults wins.
2. The dismount from pony and remount to bicycle will not be timed.
3. 128cm class will be 70cm
4. 138cm class will be 80cm
5. First prize is a bicycle for each class.

148cm Speed with Joker

1. Competitors will jump a round of fences which will be a standard Table A speed.
2. The course will be 1.10m.
3. After passing the finish line, competitors will have the option of jumping a “Joker” fence, this fence will be approximately 1.30m high.
4. If the rider opts to jump the Joker and clears it then 5 seconds will be removed from their overall time; however, if the rider incurs faults at the Joker then 5 seconds will be added to their overall time.
5. If jumping the Joker then riders must jump it before leaving the arena and within 10 seconds of crossing the finish line. Jumping the Joker will not be timed.

148cm Retiring Riders

The Parade

1. The Parade of Retiring Riders will be in the Main Indoor Arena.
2. Riders should be on horseback (it does not need to be the pony competing in the Retiring Riders competition) and wearing formal riding clothes (i.e. not fancy dress).
3. Riders will parade around the arena on horseback to music.
4. Riders will then dismount in the warm-up arena (you should have someone on hand to hold your pony) and re-enter the arena on foot for the presentation of medals.

The Class

1. Retiring riders is fancy dress and there will be prizes for best dressed.
2. Riders MUST use a 148cm pony. Horses, smaller ponies or any other type of animal will not be permitted to enter the warm-up or the arena under any circumstances.
3. Ponies MUST be fully tacked in accordance with normal SJI rules.
4. Riders MUST wear riding helmets.
5. Tack and rider's attire will be inspected prior to entering the arena. Riders MUST co-operate with inspectors, failure to do so could lead to disqualification.
6. This class will be run as a pairs Power and Speed class. One half of the course will be 90cm/1m and the other half will be 1.10m maximum.
7. Pairs to declare who is jumping Power and who Speed on the day of the competition.
8. The number of pairs permitted in the warm up arena will be restricted.
9. Pairs will not be permitted back into the warm up arena on completion of their round.
10. Competition will be run strictly in accordance with SJI rules.
11. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entries or admission without reason.
